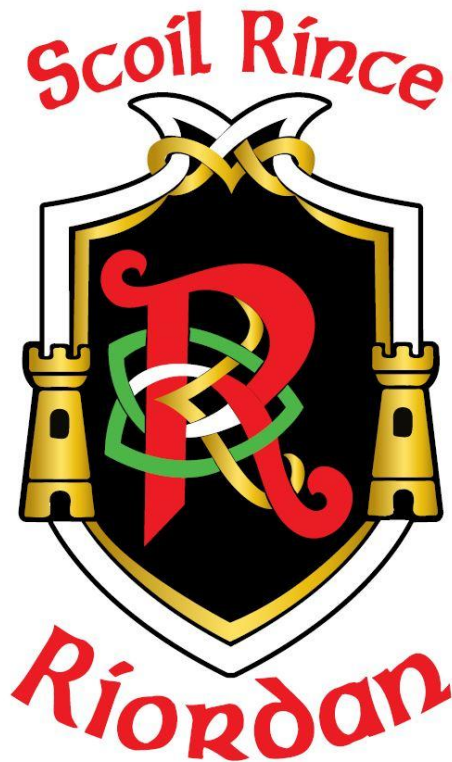

PLEASE NOTE RULING REGARDING PRELIMINARY CHAMPIONSHIPS IN MID-ATLANTIC REGION:

Open to competitors who have placed 1st in Prizewinner solo light (Reel or Slip Jig) and heavy dance (Jig or Hornpipe) at any Feis. Dancers who win THREE 1st place Preliminary Championships in one calendar year must move onto Open or as soon as the 3rd win is achieved in the following years. Girls and Boys combined. Hard Shoe danced first. Jig Speed – 73. Hornpipe Speed – 113 *The winners of our perpetual awards will keep the trophy for one year and must return it to Scoil Rince Riordan no later than three full weeks before the next Scoil Rince Riordan Feis.
